\*NOTE: There are 2,062 distinct reports captured in VAERS, and 829 distinct Covid reports captured, through 7/2/2021. Some patients met multiple criteria; therefore there are 2,126 total instances displayed in this report for the same time period, and 852 Covid instances displayed; but each distinct row includes only distinct patient reports (no duplicates) and percentages are calculated as a percent of total patient reports received. For instance, some patients have both "foetal loss" and "stillbirth" noted as symptoms in the same adverse event record. However, each single row on this report shows only the patients in that category, with no duplicates.
