***NOTE:** There are 2,221 distinct pregnancy loss events captured in VAERS, and 983 distinct Covid-19 associated pregnancy loss events captured, through 7/16/2021. Some patients met multiple criteria; therefore there are 2,291 total instances of pregnancy loss including 1,012 instances of Covid-19 associated pregnancy loss displayed in this report. But each value displayed on this report includes only distinct patient records (no duplicates) and percentages are calculated as a percent of total patient reports received. For instance, when both "foetal loss" and "stillbirth" are noted in a single adverse event record, that patient's record will populate two instances in two categories on this report.
