DAN COX DEMONSTRATES CONVICTION AND COURAGE IN PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF MARYLAND CITIZENS.

- *Dan has fiercely defended our right to informed medical choice in both the private sector and the Maryland state legislature.*

WHY IS **YOUR VOTE** SO **IMPORTANT** IN THIS ELECTION?

- THE CDC VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO APPROVE COVID-19 VACCINES FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN.
- On October 20th, the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices voted 15-0 in favor of including Covid-19 vaccines in the standard recommendations for all children over 6 months old, despite the risk of adverse effects.
- This means that the Maryland state legislature can vote to require Covid-19 vaccines for attendance in Maryland schools and activities. Only Maryland legislators committed to parental rights, medical freedom, and informed choice stand between our children and vaccine mandates.
- Dan Cox will oppose mandatory Covid-19 vaccines for children to attend school and extra-curricular activities.
